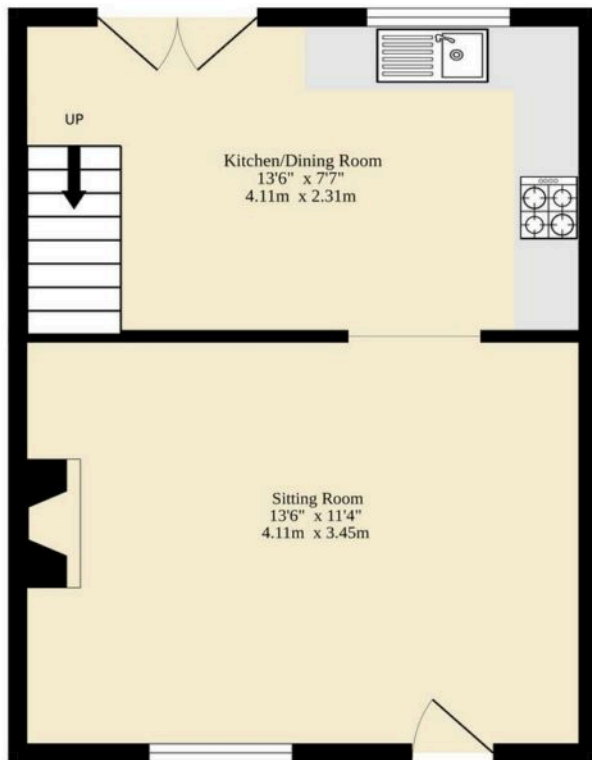

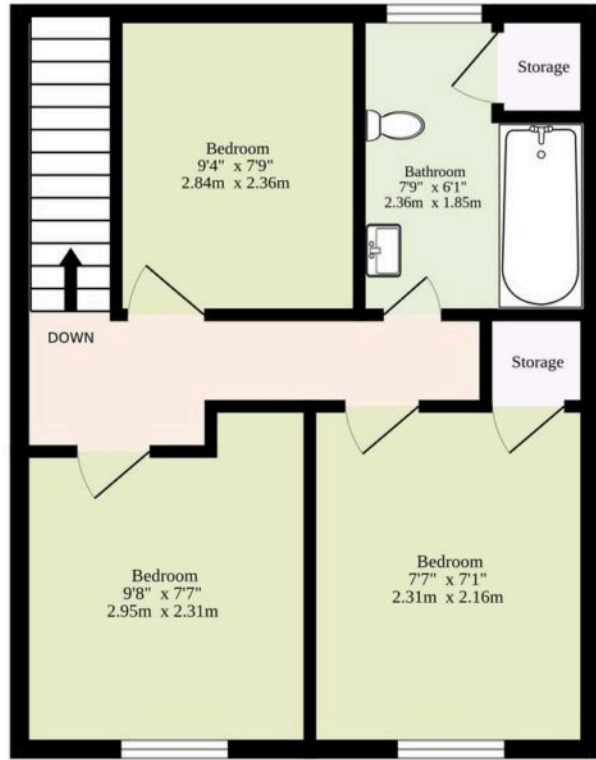
The open-plan layout works beautifully, keeping the space sociable and connected.
