Inside, character meets comfort: a modern kitchen with an Aga, a study with field views, and a sitting room with beams, a log burner, and patio doors opening to the outdoors. The dining room completes the trio of welcoming reception spaces. Upstairs, three bedrooms include a master with storage, while the family bathroom boasts a generous corner bath. Balancing countryside calm with the charm of the nearby beach, this is a home that captures the very best of rural–coastal living.



Manor Farm Cottage, Walcott



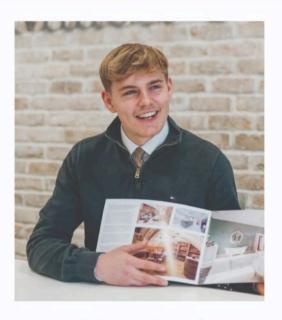
