

The Barns At The Croft Cheneys Lane

Forncett St. Mary, Norwich

The Barns at Forncett St Mary is a masterpiece of South Norfolk living, a period barn conversion of over 3,000 sq. ft. set within approximately half an acre (STMS) of landscaped grounds. Vaulted ceilings, exposed beams, flagstone floors and a striking garden room embody character and craftsmanship, while a contemporary Shaker kitchen, underfloor heating and thoughtfully designed reception spaces bring modern elegance. Five bedrooms, three with en-suites, are complemented by a beautifully integrated self-contained annexe offering two further bedrooms and private facilities, perfect for multi-generational living or guests. Sweeping lawns, an orchard of fruit trees, ornamental borders and sunlit terraces create an idyllic sequence of outdoor "rooms," framed by the tranquillity of the Tas Valley. A sweeping shingle driveway, garage, and generous parking provide practicality, while the home's Conservation Area setting enhances its heritage charm. More than a residence, The Barns is a celebration of rural luxury, blending heritage, comfort and style in one of South Norfolk's most desirable locations.
